"Class of the Fearless" 2024:

A new chapter begins for Fulbright's brave new graduates

Ho Chi Minh City, June 8, 2024 – A memorable graduation ceremony was held for 128 new graduates of Fulbright University Vietnam at the Saigon South Marina Club (SSMC). This ceremony celebrated the achievements and remarkable journeys of the Class of 2024 - a cohort that commenced their studies at Fulbright when the Fulbright Undergraduate Program just entered its second year with special milestones. They endured two years of the COVID-19 pandemic, confronting unprecedented challenges in their educational pursuits and personal growth. Throughout this, they learned to be resilient, to grow, and to thrive amidst adversity. We proudly refer to the new Bachelors of the class of 2024 as "Class of the Fearless".

A pioneering generation for positive contributions and social impacts

In this Class of 2024, 26 students graduated with Distinction and 35 students with Capstone Honors, with many individuals making impactful contributions and achieving notable results in social projects, entrepreneurships, professional development, and academic pursuits.

Nguyen Duy Hieu, who majored in Integrated Sciences focusing on Biology and Neuroscience and minored in Psychology, was accepted into PhD programs at two leading universities in the United States: the Neuroscience program at Stony Brook University and the Physiology & Neuroscience program at the University of Connecticut.

Tran Viet Hoang and Tran Hoan Nhi with HNVision – an AI-based mobile application aimed at supporting visually impaired people to actively operate household appliances in the house. Starting from Hoang's experiences as a blind Computer Science student trying to navigate his surroundings, he and Nhi developed an application that allows blind users to control devices using features such as photo and video recording, voice commands, touch input, and fingerprint recognition, all designed to enable easy and effective interaction.

Pham Hoang Lan, a student in Human-centered Engineering and serving as the Project Lead, brought forth a practical initiative to address food scarcity during the COVID-19 pandemic – the Hearty Plant. This is an automatic hydroponic growing solution,



designed to enhance urban agriculture through innovative technology: Plants are initially nurtured outdoors, then transferred to a system that mixes nutrients with a circulating pump, and utilizes sensors to adjust light and humidity for optimal growth. In the future, the project aims to gather and adjust data using artificial intelligence to enhance its efficiency. Lân has been awarded a scholarship for a Master's program in Embedded Systems Foundations of Cyber-Physical Systems and the Internet of Things at the University of California, Irvine, USA.
